

Note: Substantial cross funding exists among these funders, so the “true source” of contributions is unclear. For example, the RI AFL-CIO and RIFTHP annually provide general funds to the RI ACLU. Thus, when the RI ACLU contributes money to the “No” coalition, the source of the contribution is ambiguous. This is a loophole in RI’s campaign finance disclosure laws that has proven intractable.

Mailer back side:

The last time Rhode Island held a Constitutional Convention, in 1986, women's reproductive rights came under attack and abortion rights were placed on the ballot.

Across the country, wealthy special interests are trying to roll back women's rights-like access to birth control-by changing State Constitutions. **We can't let that happen in Rhode Island.**

Note: This mailer doesn't observe that in 1986 RI voters overwhelmingly rejected the proposed amendment to limit a women's reproductive rights. It also doesn't explain how, if more than 90% of RI voters supported a women's right to choose, as claimed in a 2014 Planned Parenthood survey distributed to the RI General Assembly, such voters would vote against their own interests on such a high salience issue.
